Garbage and Recycling Collection Services and Rates for Unincorporated Washington County

RESIDENTIAL SERVICE RATES

Rates effective August 1, 2026

A \$ 2.00 per month recycling surcharge will be added to your bill.

This surcharge applies to all residential service types, including will-call and recycling-only service.

Will-Call Service (Less than weekly garbage collection)

Will-Call customers receive: one 32-gallon cart for garbage collection on a per-call basis, up to two 96-gallon carts for regular every-other-week recycling collection, and one red bin for regular every-other-week glass and battery collection. *Urban customers** also receive one 60-gallon cart for regular every-other-week yard debris and food scrap collection

Residential Recycling-Only Service

Recycling-Only customers receive: one 96-gallon cart for every-other-week recycling collection and one red bin for every-other-week glass and battery collection

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ADDITIONAL SERVICES AND FEES

Rates effective August 1, 2026

Additional Yard Debris Services

*Includes every-other-week collection of yard debris and food scraps using the hauler-provided 60-gallon cart.
Available to urban* customers only.*

Yard Debris-Only Service: Available to all urban customers who <u>do not</u> already subscribe to <i>Standard Residential Can/Cart Collection Service</i> or is an add-on service for <i>Standard Commercial Can/Cart Collection Service</i> customers.	\$6.30/mon.
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Additional Yard Debris Cart: Available to <i>Standard Can/Cart Collection</i> and <i>Yard Debris-Only</i> customers.	\$5.07/mon.
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Extra Can/Bag/Bundle of Yard Debris: Available to <i>Standard Residential</i> and <i>Yard Debris-Only</i> customers.	\$4.07/each
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Effective October 1, 2023: Residential customers can add food scraps to the yard debris collection cart

Other Services and Fees

Extra Bag/Bundle of Garbage: Applies to properly bagged or bundled materials outside the cart.		\$8.46	\$9.20
Over-Capacity Charge: Fee charged to can/cart customers when the garbage container is overfilled. A good indicator of over-filling is that the lid does not close.		\$3.18	\$3.24
Commercial Receptacle Cleaning Fee: Charged per occurrence, per receptacle for cleaning or swap-out based on customer request. Annually, commercial food scraps collection customers receive one free cleaning or swap-out per receptacle.		\$19.16	\$19.54
Call Backs: Charged when pickup is missed due to customer error. <i>See Administrative Rules Section 8(M)(a)(7)(5).</i>		\$19.18	\$20.39
Distance Charge: Monthly fee charged to residential can/cart customers when receptacles are placed more than 5 feet from the curbside or the roadside. Haulers shall provide non-curbside or non-roadside residential collection service at no extra charge to disabled residential customers. <i>See Administrative Rules Section 8(E)(b)(4).</i>	5 feet to 150 feet	\$17.62	\$13.82
	151 feet or greater	\$27.10	\$23.49
Drop Box/Compactor Service Interference Fee: Charged when the driver is unable to safely service a compactor/drop box because of site issues such as blocked access to the compactor/drop box.		\$36.58	\$73.15
Drop Box Relocation Fee: Charged when the customer requests that the collection company make a special trip to the site to relocate a drop box on the same site.		\$36.58	\$73.15
Commercial Compactor Turn-Around Fee: Charged per occurrence when collection requires the driver to turn around the compactor.		\$36.58	
Locked Containers/Doors Fee: Applicable if a commercial customer utilizes locks on the container or enclosure gate that requires the collection company driver to unlock the container or gate.		\$10.00 per month/per lock	

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Unreturned Cart Fee: Applies only to residential service. <i>See Administrative Rules Section 8(R)(g).</i>	\$50.00
NSF Charge: Charged for insufficient funds.	\$30.00
Reinstatement Fee: Charged after cancellation for non-payment.	\$25.00
Unscheduled Service: Charged for non-routine service related to the collection of waste, such as wait times in excess of 15 minutes or enclosure clean-outs.	\$95.00 per hour

Fees	Rate
Base charge (billed monthly)	\$2.50
Curbside* Pick-up Fee (each): collection container is placed within 5ft. of the curb/street	\$9.25
Non-curbside Pick-up Fee 5-150ft. (each): collection container is placed in a mutually agreed-upon location, such as at the doorstep or next to the garage	\$11.70
Non-curbside Pick-up Fee over 150ft. (each): collection container is placed in a mutually agreed-upon location, such as at the doorstep or next to the garage	\$13.02

* *Curbside* collection container is placed within 5ft. of the curb/street
