### Bulky Waste Collection Fees

There is a \$18 minimum charge for bulky waste pick-up services. This is incorporated into the 'first item' fee listed. Additional items for collection on the same day, by the same collection truck, are charged based on the rate in the additional items column.

The price groupings below include a variety of example items. This list is not meant to be exhaustive, but to be used as a guide to determine the price for items not listed.

## Commercial Compacted Container Rates

Rate is 2.25 times the loose container rate (from above chart).

Are based on containers from one to four yards, owned and maintained by the customer.

The weight per yard shall not exceed 500 pounds.

## Commercial Composting Services

Commercial composting services are available to Beaverton businesses using 1- to 8-yard containers and generating food scraps at the subscription quantity (restaurants, grocery stores, food processors, institutions, and companies with food service.)

- Collected materials are limited to food scraps and non-food items as described in the Administrative Rules for Solid Waste and Recycling.
- Contaminated loads will be collected at the standard garbage rate.
- In order to ensure that program efficiency is both cost-effective and efficient for collection routes, services may be limited to businesses generating larger quantities of food scraps.
- Food scrap collection may be available only at the onetime per week collection level. Haulers are not required to provide more frequent service until collection volume and routes enable multiple collection days.

Commercial composting customers who use a compactor or drop box for waste collection will be charged the following rates for commercial food waste collection.

Disposal Fee: The medical collection rate is the sum of the Pick-Up Fee plus the disposal Fee per unit of medical waste. Customers that have multiple containers picked-up are charged the each Pick-Up Fee. Customers that have more than 10 units of 31/43 gallon non-pathological waste containers are charged the lower unit rate for all containers.
